May Meeting Recap

At the University Staff Advisory Council meeting on May 21, several Human Resources team members joined USAC to present on the Talent Acquisition Program Initiative, which aims to streamline the recruitment process for all employee types. Following the presentation, Jennifer Wilkes, vice president for Human Resources and chief human resources officer, answered questions on the recently announced Voluntary Separation Incentive Program.

The meeting continued with internal presentations and discussion. Members of the USAC History Committee shared details on the goals and accomplishments of the ad hoc committee, which was established in 2023 to develop a process for archiving USAC information. Finally, USAC further discussed recently proposed changes to its membership model after reviewing feedback from meetings in April. This effort has been underway for several months as the council seeks to update the structure of the Council to allow for increased representation from staff across the University. Following the discussion, a motion was made and approved to update the USAC membership model to include a seat for one representative from each campus, college, and unit, in addition to a small number of at-large members who will apply for membership under the current process. The council will continue to further define the details of this model throughout the next year, and it will take effect in July 2025.

- Communications The committee completed updates to the <u>USAC website</u>, made multiple posts on USAC's social media channels, and drafted the monthly brief. The committee also completed a news story on the <u>USAC Awards</u> and is working on the annual report.
- **Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, & Belonging** The DEIB committee is aggregating and evaluating data from the 2024 listening sessions to create a report on the trends and themes from the sessions.
- Logistics The committee assisted the Awards and Recognition Committee with the Awards Ceremony
 event and the Outreach and Engagement Committee with the upcoming community engagement
 meeting.

• Outreach and Engagement – The committee is planning the final Regional Engagement meeting at the Beaver campus on June 20.
