April General Council Meeting Highlights

• Employee Health Plan Updates – Jennifer Wilkes, vice president for human resources and chief human resources officer, and Jill Musser, senior director of benefits, shared updates on the University's ongoing efforts to manage rising health care costs while continuing to support employees. Currently, more than 17,500 employees are enrolled in a Penn State health plan (either the PPO Plan or High-Deductible Savings Plan). Penn State remains committed to its cost-sharing model, with the University covering 75% of health care costs and employees contributing 25%. Beginning September 1, 2025, Penn State will introduce Scripta, a free prescription cost-saving service available to employees and their covered dependents enrolled in a Penn State health plan.

Updates from USAC

- **USAC Strategic Planning Process** The draft strategic plan has been finalized and is currently under review by USAC committee chairs and officers. A vote on the new plan will take place at the May General Council meeting.
- USAC Annual Summit, June 11, 2025 This daylong event will focus on team-building activities for USAC members and local staff advisory councils. The keynote address will be delivered by Nalini Krishnankutty, Program Manager for Diversity, Inclusion, and Belonging in Penn State Human Resources.
